Login and password information is unique to each individual. Login information may be obtained through the main office of your child's school.


Skyward Mobile allows you to access information (view only) stored in Skyward's School Management System using any mobile device. As a student or guardian, you may use Skyward Mobile to access Student and Family Access to view student information, such as your student's attendance and discipline records. Skyward Mobile helps you play a more involved role in your student's education—even when you're on the go.

The following is a brief explanation of the tabs to the left:

- Calendar** displays absences, tardies, grades, assignments, messages, activity events, notes, test and school day information.
- Gradebook** displays the student's current year Gradebook data for all classes. This may include midterm, term, semester, assignment, skill and subject grades. Missing assignments, online assignments, and teacher comments. A student must be logged in to Student Access to complete an online assignment.
- Attendance** allows you to view the student's tardies and absences. You may also provide reason for your student's absence.
- Student Information** displays demographic, family, and emergency contact information. Guardians may click the link at the top, right corner of the screen to request change(s) to a student's information.
- Schedule** displays the student's class schedule.
- Discipline** displays the student's discipline records.
- Test Scores** allows you to view standardized or diagnostic assessments.
- Activities** allow you to view the student's activities (for example, softball, chess club, etc.).
- Educational Milestones** are requirements that the student must complete in order to graduate. As a student gets closer to graduation, the list of Milestones will increase.
- Teacher Conferences** are teacher enabled conferences times and may not be available in Family Access.
- Academic History** displays the student's grade history for all classes in Bethel School District.
- Portfolio** enables you to view and download report cards.
- Health Information** displays the students health records. Student vaccination records may be viewed and printed.
- Login History** displays history of logins into your Family or Student Access account.
