It is hereby agreed between Green River Community College and Bethel School District, hereafter referred to as the Affiliating Agency, that the affiliating agency will accept Occupational Therapy Assistant students for experience in clinical procedures.

This agreement is to be governed by the following conditions:

1. The purpose of the affiliation shall be to establish a learning experience for the student and the student's activity shall be governed by the course of study set by Green River Community College and the Occupational Therapy department of the affiliating agency. The students shall be enrolled in and progressing normally in the Occupational Therapy Assistant program.
2. The clinical facilities used by the students shall meet the standards of all appropriate accrediting organizations.
3. The students of Green River Community College shall be instructed and supervised by appropriate staff of the Occupational Therapy department at the affiliating agency. The affiliating agency shall designate an appropriate member(s) of their staff to act as clinical instructor(s). If the affiliating agency does not have an

Occupational Therapy department, students will be supervised by the appropriate staff as agreed upon by the Green River Community College Occupational Therapy department and the affiliating agency.

4. The number of hours and days of the week utilized for student clinical experience shall be approved by mutual agreement of Green River Community College and appropriate personnel of the affiliating agency. A list of students scheduled for clinical experience shall be provided by Green River Community College prior to the beginning of each quarter students are scheduled to be in the affiliating agency.
5. Emergency health care for on-the-job injuries to the student shall be provided by the affiliating agency. The student will assume financial responsibility for emergency care.
6. Students are covered by personal student liability insurance as provided through the Health Occupations Division of Green River Community College.
7. The affiliating agency shall provide locker space for the students as well as a room for student-faculty conferences, as is available.
8. Unless otherwise agreed upon, compensation is not a part of this agreement and no fee or stipend shall be earned by the student, nor shall either party expect remuneration other than the mutual benefits derived from the teaching program. The affiliating agency may elect, as its option, to furnish meals, laundry, parking, etc., to students as a part of the affiliation.
9. Students and instructors are expected to conform to the rules and regulations of the affiliating agency. Infractions shall be

reported to the Green River Community College Occupational Therapy Assistant Program, immediately.

10. The affiliating agency may request withdrawal or dismissal of a student to Green River Community College whose performance record or conduct is unsatisfactory or whose personal characteristics prevent desirable relationships or do not justify continuance in clinical practice at the affiliating agency.
11. During the performance of this contract, all parties to this contract shall comply with all Federal and State nondiscrimination laws, regulations and policies.
12. In the event of noncompliance or refusal to comply with any nondiscrimination law, regulation, or policy, this contract may be rescinded, cancelled or terminated in whole or in part.
13. The State of Washington, including all its agencies and departments, is self-insured for all exposure to tort liability, general liability, property damage liability, and vehicle liability as provided for in the Risk Management Act, Revised Code of Washington, Chapter 43.19.19362.
14. The Tort Claims Act, RCW 4.92 et seq., provides the fundamental remedy for all liability claims against the State. Such claims must be filed with the Division of Risk Management for processing according to statute.
15. This agreement shall be effective until terminated by either party by giving written notice of intent to cancel 90 days prior to the time students would be assigned to the clinical education experience provided by the affiliating agency.

16. "Each party to this agreement shall be responsible for claims and damages to persons or property resulting from acts or omissions on the part of itself, its employees, its agents, or its officers. Neither party assumes any responsibility to the other party of the consequences of any acts of omission of any person, firm, or corporation not a party to this agreement. Neither party to this agreement shall be considered the agent of the other party."
